

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the Southery Road from its junction with Decoy Road for a distance of 1 mile south eastwards to Feltwell village bridge in the PARISH OF FELTWELL because of carriageway patching by NCC.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 5th November 2018 to 8th November 2018 for the duration of the works, expected to be 4 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: B1112, A134, B1160 (Stoke Ferry/ West Dereham/ Feltwell/ Methwold/ Southery/ Northwold/ Wereham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

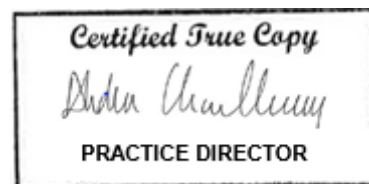

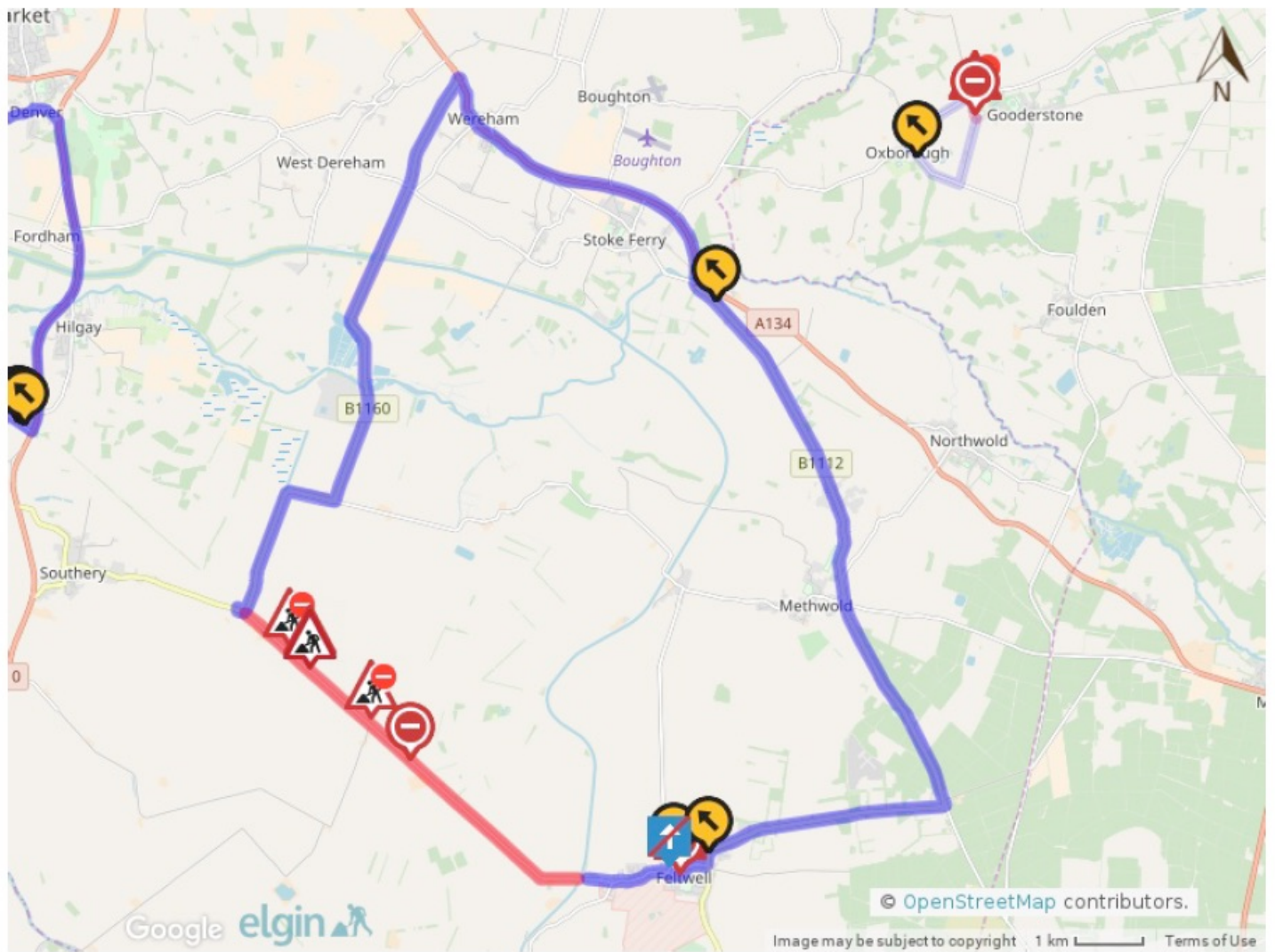
