

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the Southery Road from a point 1 Kilometre from its junction with Blackdyke Road for a distance of 3 Kilometres north westwards in the PARISH OF FELTWELL because of resurfacing works by NCC.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 07:30 and 16:00 hours from 9th January 2019 to 25th January 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be 17 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Southery Road, Feltwell Road, Decoy Road, College Road, Wereham Bypass, Lynn Road, Stoke Road, Stoke Ferry Bypass (a134), Whittington Hill, Methwold Road, Main Road, Brandon Road, Lodge Road, Oak Street, Bell Street, High Street, Long Lane C872 B1160 (Methwold/ Feltwell/ Southery/ West Dereham/ Wereham/ Northwold/ Stoke Ferry).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

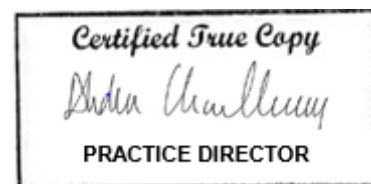
