TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

1. ORDER temporarily prohibiting the use by vehicles of the C61 Saint Marys Street (full length) in Feltwell ("the Road")
2. The Norfolk County Council, as Traffic Authority for Norfolk, is satisfied that the holding of the Feltwell - Royal British Legion Remembrance Parade is required to take place along the Road and that in consequence traffic over the Road should be prohibited on 10th November 2019 for the duration of the Feltwell - Royal British Legion Remembrance Parade, expected to be between 09:30hrs to 12:30hrs
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply:
 - a) to anything done with the permission, or at the direction, of a police constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or for the purposes of a statutory undertaker, in an emergency which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of the Road
4. Insofar as any provisions of this Order conflict with any provisions of any previous Order relating to the Road, the provisions of this Order shall prevail

The Norfolk County Council HEREBY ORDERS that on 10th November 2019 for the duration of the Feltwell - Royal British Legion Remembrance Parade the use of the Road by vehicles shall be PROHIBITED
