TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Royal British Legion Remembrance Parade, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the C61 Saint Marys Street (full length) in the PARISH OF Feltwell.

The Order will come into effect on 10th November 2019 and will remain in force for 3 hours. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on 10th November 2019 between 09:30hrs and 12:30hrs. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed

Alternative route will be via: Northbound traffic: C61 The Beck; B1112 Oak Street; C87 Bell Street. Southbound traffic: C872 High Street; C871 Short Beck; C61 Short Beck; C61 Hill Street.

The promoter of the event is Feltwell Parish Council.
