

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) Hythe Road from its junction with Hill Street for a distance of 115 metres north westwards and 2) Short Beck from its junction with Hill Street for a distance of 22 metres southwards in the PARISH OF FELTWELL because of UKPN restring to overhead electrical cables works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 09:00 and 15:00 hours on 28th November 2019 for the duration of the works, expected to be 6 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: Short Beck, Long Lane, Southery Road, Feltwell Road, Decoy Road, Broad Drove, Severalls Road, Methwold Road, Hythe Road (Southery, Feltwell, Methwold)

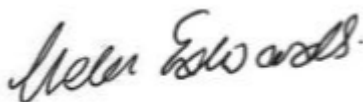
(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

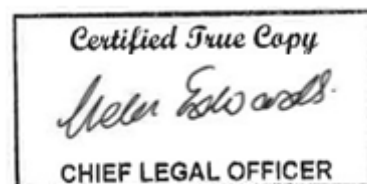

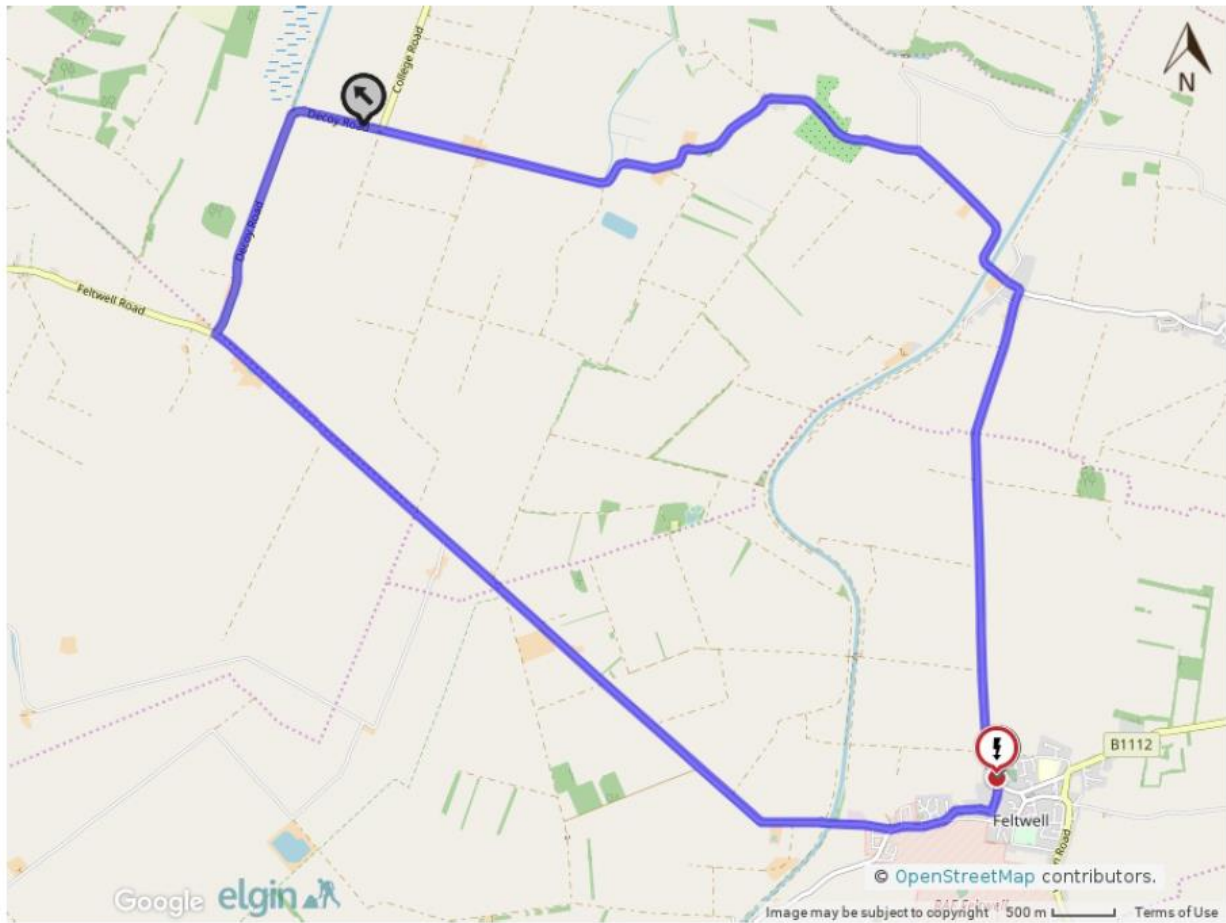
