

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the B1112 Brandon Road from its junction with Northwold Road for a distance of 770 metres southwards in the PARISH OF METHWOLD because of NCC resurfacing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 07:00 and 19:00 hours from 26th October 2020 to 30th October 2020 for the duration of the works, expected to be 5 days within the period. These dates replace any dates previously advertised at this location.

Alternative route is via: Through Traffic: B1112 Stoke Road/ Main Road/ Methwold Road, A134 Whittington Hill/ Thetford Road/ Lynn Road/ Cranwich Road, A1065 Brandon Road/ Mundford Road, C873 Brandon Road/ Lynn Road, B1112 Brandon Road (Methwold/ Northwold/ Cranwich/ Mundford/ Weeting with Broomhill). Methwold Village Traffic: C872 High Street/ Crown Street/ Hythe Road/ Methwold Road/ Feltwell Road/ Hythe Road, C61 Short Beck/ Hill Street/ The Beck, Clockwise B1112 Oak Street, C872 Bell Street/ High Street/ Short Beck. B1112 Lodge Road to join main diversion (Methwold/ Feltwell). C41 Mundford Road and Methwold Road traffic to join main diversion at A134 Cranwich Road junction (Methwold).

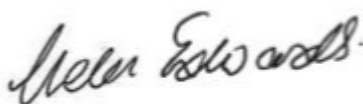
(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

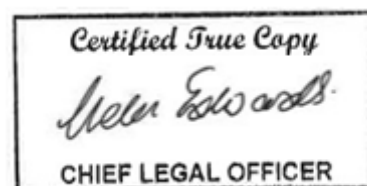

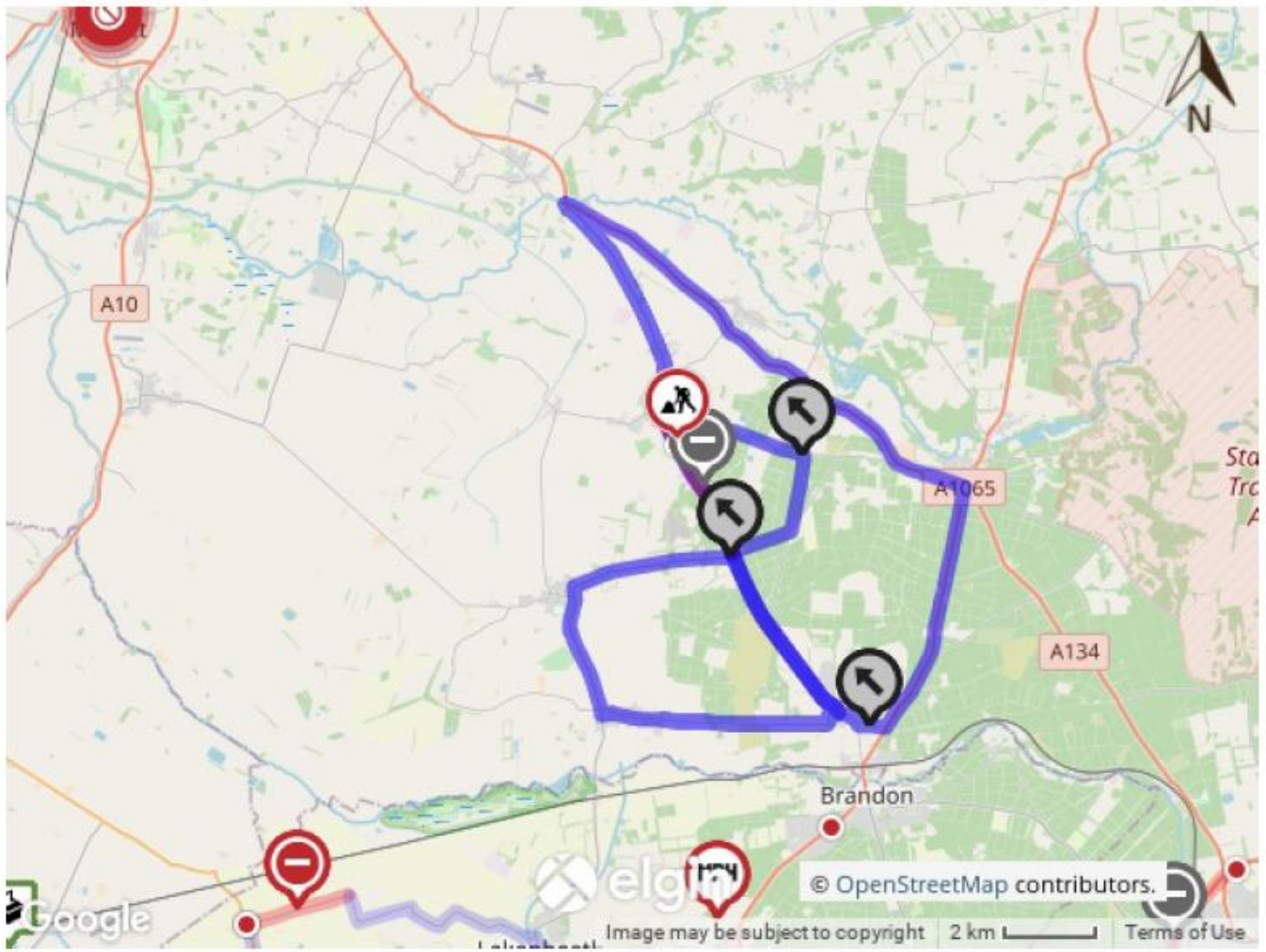
