

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) High Street from its junction with St Marys Street to its junction with Short Beck; 2) Lime Kiln Lane from its junction with High Street to its junction with Short Lane; 3) Short Beck from its junction with High Street to its junction with Hill Street; 4) Hill Street from its junction with Short Beck to its junction with St Marys Street; 5) High Street from its junction with St Marys Street to its junction with Lime Kiln Lane; and 6) Short Beck from its junction with Hill Street for a distance of 83 metres southwards; in the PARISH OF FELTWELL because of NCC resurfacing works.

The roads 1), 2), 3) and 4) will be temporarily closed (except for access), road 5) will be temporarily subject to a suspension of the one-way restriction (eastbound), and road 6) will be temporarily subject to a suspension of the one-way restriction (north bound) from 3rd January 2021 to 8th January 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 6 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: St Marys Street, Bell Street, Oak Street, Lodge Road, Brandon Road, Stoke Road, Main Road, Methwold Road, Whittington Hill, Stoke Ferry Bypass (A134), Lynn Road, Wereham Bypass, College Road, Decoy Road, Feltwell Road, Southery Road, Long Lane, Short Lane, Short Beck, Hill Street (Southery/ Feltwell/ Northwold/ Wereham/ Stoke Ferry/ Methwold/ West Dereham).

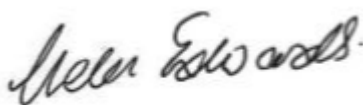
(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
