

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the 1) High Street from its junction with Mulberry Close for a distance of 150m west; and 2) the one-way system comprising of High Street, Short Beck, Hill Street and Saint Mary's Street in the PARISH OF FELTWELL because of UKPN overhead cabling works.

The road 1) will be temporarily closed (except for access) and road 2) will be temporarily subject to a suspension of the one-way restriction (clockwise) between 08:30 hours to 23:59 on 6th April 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 15 ½ hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: High Street, Bell Street, Wilton Road, Feltwell Road, Black Dyke Road, Long Lane (Feltwell/ Hockwold cum Wilton).

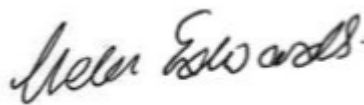
(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

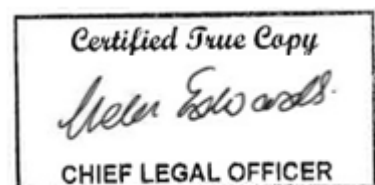

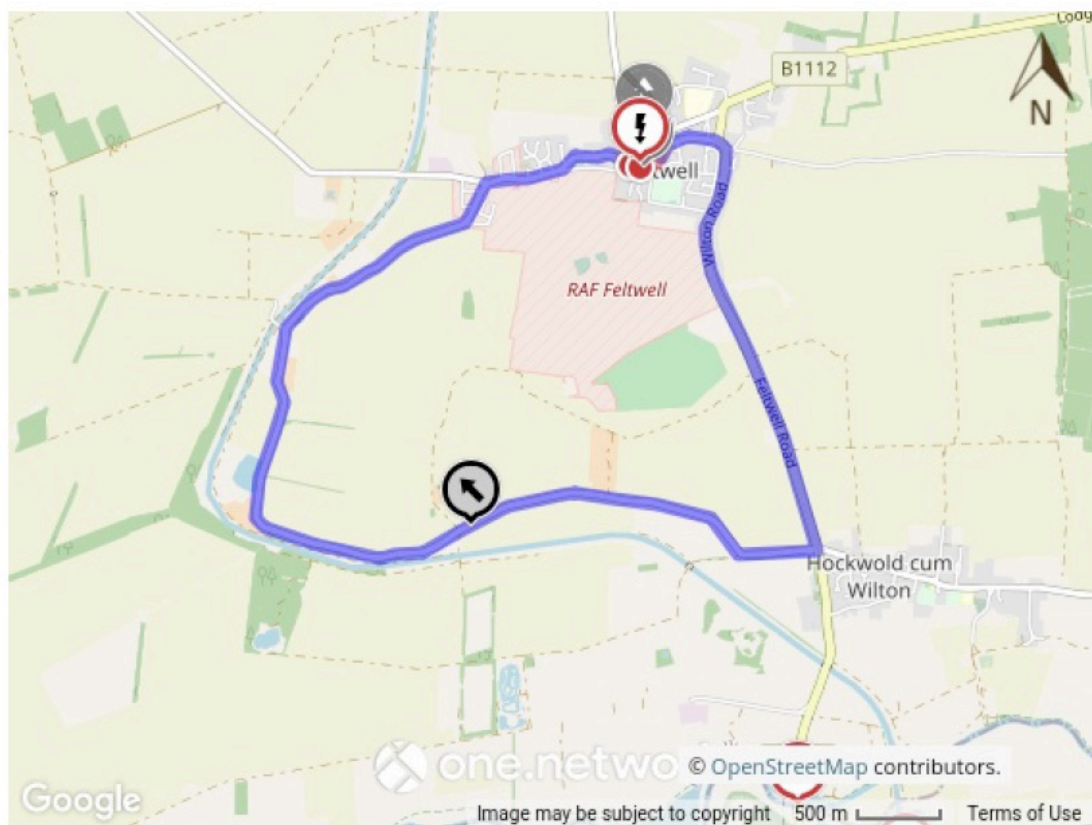

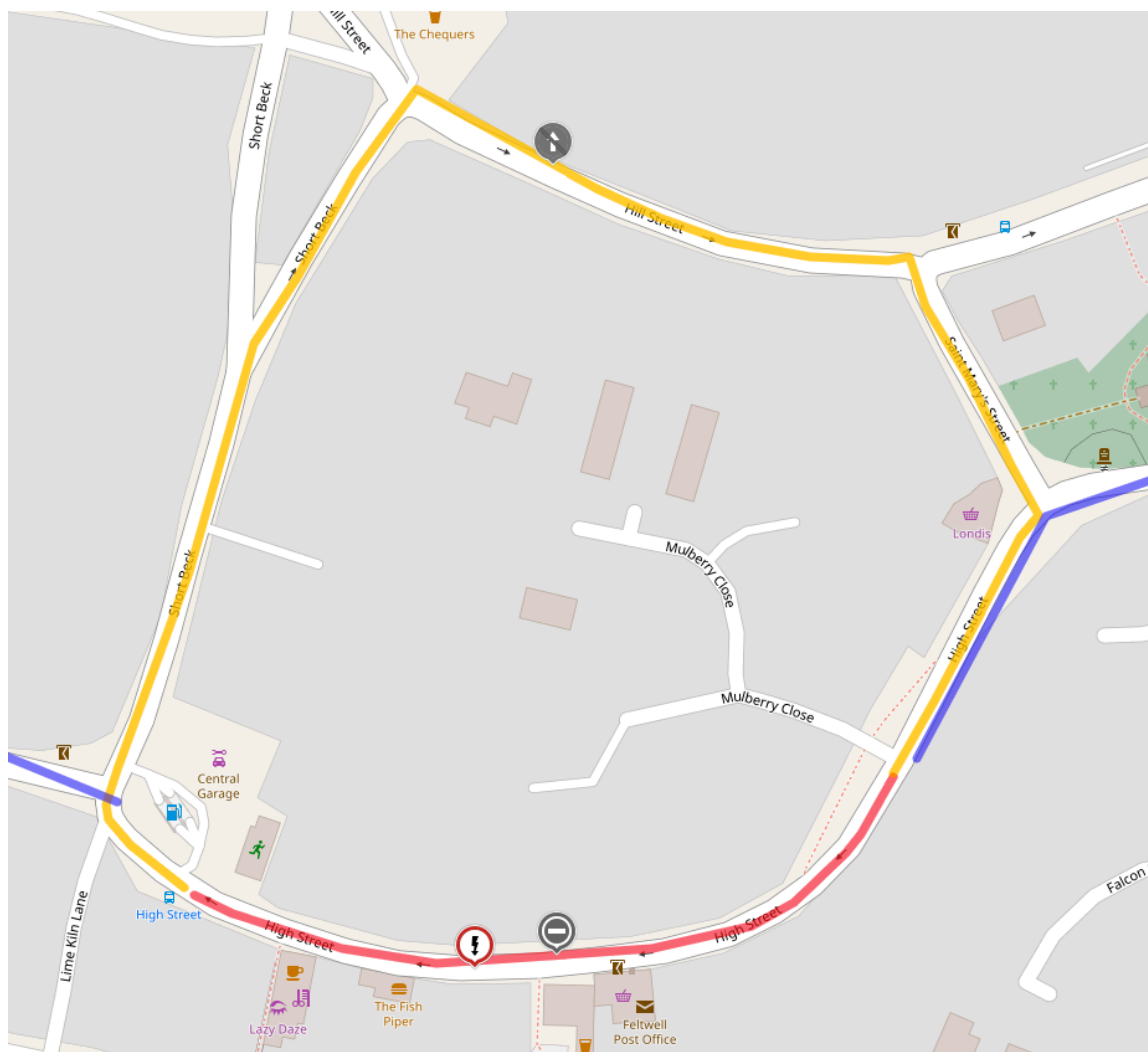
