

MINUTE 195 (Annual Parish)

The Annual Parish Meeting was held on Monday 13th MAY 2019 at the British Legion, Long Lane – commencing 7.00 pm. Accounts on show.

COUNCILLOR'S PRESENT: - Mr Rayner (Chairman), Mr Lambert (Vice Chair), Messrs Cock, Cole, Edwards, Rayner, Studd, Mrs Arnold, Mrs Bane and Mrs McGeeney. Also present were 7 members of the public.

APOLOGIES: None received.

DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: None.

MATTERS ARISING

1. **Amendments to the Local Plan** – The planning application for 46 houses at 10 Lodge Road has not progressed any further and a decision is still awaited.

CHARITY ACCOUNTS – Clerk gave report of Rawlins Charity – in 2018, 44 donations of £5 were made plus £10 to the church – total of £230. Balances @ 31.3.19 were £829.52 COIF Deposit and £22.63 Barclays, a total of £852.15. Mrs Bane proposed the accounts are accepted, seconded Mrs McGeeney, all agreed.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS – Members of the public were invited to speak.

2. A resident said the greenery along Short Lane needs cutting back as far as the junction with Lime Kiln Lane. The hedge at the top of Paynes Lane on the right hand side of the junction with Wilton Road also needs cutting back.

3. The deadline for the amended planning application by Hall Farm Developments has been extended until 7th June 2019. Mr Storey had spoken with the Highways Officer who said he had only looked at Google Maps but stated that although he understood the concerns, the objections raised by the Parish Council would not stand up in court. Mr Lambert said that when the application reached the Planning Committee stage on 3rd June 2019, Borough Councillors Storey and Lawrence should be approached to speak on behalf of the Parish Council and residents.

4. Mr Rayner gave an update on the website. He said 26 people have registered their emails for automatic receipt of any news items added. Over the last year, it has been viewed 3837 times. He also requested further information be supplied on items such as the war memorial, so that this too could be added to the website. Clerk to put request in Parish Magazine.
