

Norfolk County Council (Feltwell)
(Emergency Notice)
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

Notice (WTRO4484)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to Anglian Water burst main repair works the use by vehicles of the Southey Road from 6000m northwest of its junction with Ploughmans Drove for 30m north- westwards in the PARISH OF FELTWELL will be temporarily prohibited from 6th to 12th October 2023 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order or further Notice to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

Alternative route is via: Southery Road, Feltwell Road, Decoy Road, College Road, Wereham Bypass, Nowhere Lane, Flegg Green, Lynn Road, Stoke Road, Stoke Ferry Bypass (A134), Whittington Hill, Methwold Road, Main Road, High Street, Crown Street, Hythe Road, Short Beck, Long Lane, Short Lane (Southery Northwold Wereham, Stoke Ferry, Methwold, Feltwell).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
