

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4899) affecting the Black Drove from its junction with Southery Road for 1320m southwards in the PARISH OF FELTWELL to facilitate Norfolk County Council recycling of carriageway works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 17th May 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 26th to 30th May 2024 (previously 22nd to 25th May 2024) for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Cross Bank Lane, Black Drove, Feltwell Road, Long Drove, Sedge Fen Road, Ferry Bank, Westgate Street, Churchgate Street, Mill Lane (Southery, Feltwell, Methwold)

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

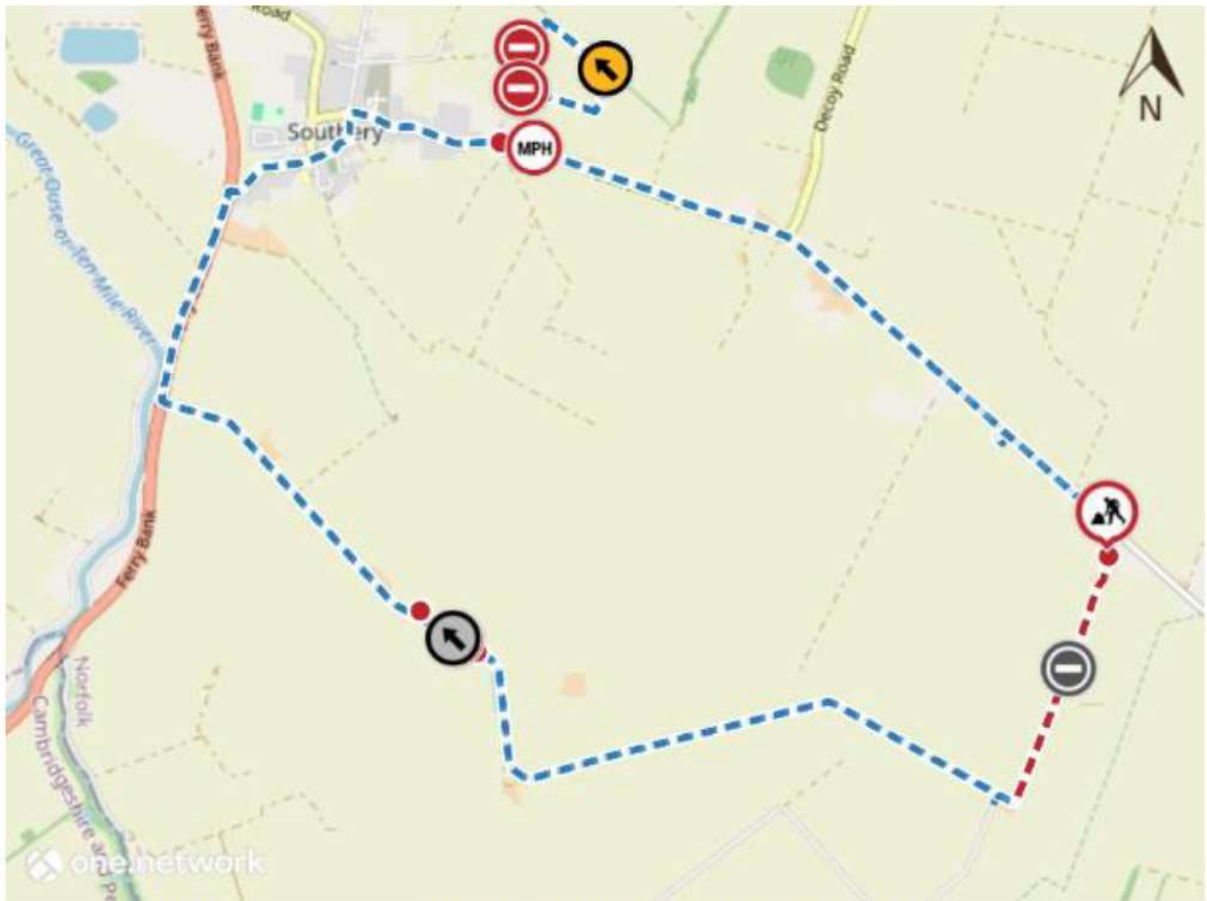
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
