

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (WTRO6457) affecting the U21506 Anchor Drove (Feltwell Iron Bridge) from the north end of the bridge for 40 metres southwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Feltwell owing to the weak structural condition of the bridge. The Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 18th December 2025 that the Road will be subject to the temporary imposition of a 7.5 tonne weight restriction for the duration of the period the restriction is necessary which is anticipated to be from 23rd January 2026 to 12th June 2027 (previously 2nd to 22nd January 2026).

Alternative route is via: N/A.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke when the restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 12th June 2027 without further notice.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
